The revised laws have been designed to make it easier for the community to understand the local laws and subordinate local laws.

Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2018 (LL2)	Not applicable	Not applicable	To regulate and manage the keeping and control of animals in TRC region in a way that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ensures a proper place for the inclusion of pets in the community • balances community expectations with the rights of individuals • protects the community against risks to health and safety • prevents pollution and other environmental damage • protects the amenity of the local community and environment.
	Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2018	LL2	To supplement LL2, which provides for regulation of the keeping of and control of animals within the TRC region.

Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environment) 2018 (LL3)	Not applicable	Not applicable	To protect the environment, public health, safety and amenity within the TRC region.
	Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environment) 2018	LL3	To support LL3 by providing schedules that must be read in conjunction with this local law: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • declaring animals or plants or specified species to be local pests • exempting certain persons in relation to declared pests • prohibiting lighting and maintaining of fires • prescribing requirements relating to community safety hazards • prescribing noise standards • waste management
Local Law No. 4 (Advertising Devices) 2018	Not applicable	Not applicable	To enable TRC to prevent or regulate advertising devices not regulated by the TRC Planning Scheme.
Local Law No. 5 (Temporary Homes) 2018	Not applicable	Not applicable	To regulate the use of a temporary home that is not regulated under the planning scheme.
Local Law No. 6 (Camping Grounds, Caravan Parks and Shared Facilities Accommodation) 2018	Not applicable	Not applicable	To enable the local government to regulate activities, that are not development, relating to public health and safety that occur in the operation of camping grounds, caravan parks and shared facilities accommodation. To protect people using the camping grounds, caravan parks and shared facilities accommodation by providing for necessities, and healthy and safe environs.
Local Law No. 7 (Human Remains and Cemeteries) 2018	Not applicable	Not applicable	To regulate the appropriate treatment of human remains in a befitting and respectful way.

Local Law No. 8 (Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2018 (LL8)	Not applicable	Not applicable	<p>To allow the use of TRC- controlled areas and roads where there is a positive community benefit in allowing that use.</p> <p>To decline the use of TRC- controlled areas and roads where there is a negative community outcome in allowing that use.</p> <p>To balance the public interest against the competing private interest in granting a permit.</p> <p>To protect the health and safety of persons using TRC-controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.</p> <p>To protect the health and safety of persons using TRC-controlled roads to the extent that TRC has assumed responsibility for the management of the state controlled road.</p> <p>To preserve features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of TRC-controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.</p> <p>To protect the environment and public health, safety and amenity within TRC region.</p>
	Subordinate Local Law No. 8 (Local Government Controlled Areas and Roads) 2018	LL8	To supplement LL8 in order to allow appropriate use of and to protect the health and safety of persons using TRC- controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads, and preserve features of the natural and built environment and other aspects of the amenity of TRC-controlled land, facilities, infrastructure and roads.
Local Law No. 9 (Parking) 2018 (LL9)	Not applicable	Not applicable	To regulate parking to enable appropriate and fair access throughout the TRC region, and provide greater controls in areas where parking is in greater demand and through off-street regulated parking areas
	Subordinate Local Law No. 9 (Parking) 2018	LL9	To support LL9 to regulate parking on local government controlled areas and roads.

Local Law No. 10 (Town Water) 2018	Not applicable	Not applicable	<p>To provide for the installation of water meters.</p> <p>To read water meters.</p> <p>To provide maintenance to and around water meters.</p> <p>To calculate water usage.</p> <p>To estimate water usage.</p> <p>To charge for water use and use of water infrastructure.</p> <p>To monitor water loss and waste.</p>
